4.1. Grading system of the institution

In the Spanish university system, ratings are based on the total score of 10 points, with one decimal allowed, obtained by the student in each subject, according to the following scale:

- Fail (SS): 0-4,9
- Pass (AP): 5 to 6.9
- Good (NT): 7 to 8.9
- Excellent (SB): 9-10

A subject is considered overcome from Pass (5).
